

## The Distinguished Service Award

The Distinguished Service Award (DSA) was established during the 1991-92 administrative year as the “Kiwanian of the Year” Award under Past Governor John Roberto. The DSA offers clubs the opportunity to recognize, at the District level, a Kiwanian or community member for outstanding service. The award is presented for “many hours of service to Kiwanis and the community.” The donation of \$150 (which may come from a club’s service account) supports our Pediatric Trauma Program, club grants, Service Leadership Programs Scholarships & Leadership Training and our other program services.

If at all possible, the presentation of the DSA should be made at the Governor’s Official Visit. This brings the recipient the honor they deserve. The Governor makes a very special and personal presentation to each recipient, which will be a highlight of the Governor’s visit.

Ambassadors and Lt. Governors receive recognition at the District Convention if they have achieved 100% club participation in their division.
